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NEWCOMERS CLUB OF FALMOUTH, INC. VOLUNTEER-LED ACTIVITIES—ACKNOWLEDGMENT, ASSUMPTION OF RISKS, RELEASE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE AGREEMENT

***PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE DOCUMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.
ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN THIS DOCUMENT.***

In consideration of the services of the Newcomers Club of Falmouth, Inc. (“Newcomers”), a Massachusetts non-profit corporation, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, I acknowledge and agree as follows:

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS: Newcomers provides volunteer-led recreational, social and educational activities which may include, but are not limited to, walking, hiking, backpacking, biking, skiing, canoeing, kayaking, sailing, eating, drinking, dancing, programs, social events, and transportation or travel to and from activities (referred to herein collectively as “Activities”). The leaders of these activities are volunteers. They are not paid professional guides or leaders. In all Activities, all participants share in the responsibility for their own safety and the safety of the group. Participants take responsibility for having appropriate skills, physical conditioning, equipment and supplies suitable for each of the Activities in which they participate.

The Activities include inherent and other risks, hazards and dangers that can cause or lead to injury, property damage, illness, mental or emotional trauma, paralysis, disability or death to participant or others. Some, but not all of these risks include: hazardous and unpredictable ground, water or weather conditions; misjudgments made by leaders, co-leaders, participants or others; travel that can cause potential delays or difficulties with transportation, evacuation and medical care; automobile accidents, equipment that can fail or malfunction; and the potential that the participant or others may act carelessly or recklessly. I understand that Newcomers cannot assure a participant’s safety or eliminate any of these risks. I am voluntarily participating with knowledge of these risks. Therefore, I assume and accept full responsibility for the inherent and other risks (both known and unknown) of the Activities in which I participate, and for any injury, damage, death or other loss suffered by me, resulting from those risks, and/or resulting from my own negligence or other misconduct.

RELEASE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE: I, for myself and my heirs, successors and assigns, hereby release, remise and forever discharge Newcomers and all of its officers, directors, representatives, agents, independent contractors, volunteers (including leaders and co-leaders), members and all other persons or entities associated with it (collectively the “Releasees”) from any and all claims, debts, demands, rights, actions, causes of action, including costs and attorneys’ fees, whether known or unknown, at law or in equity, which I ever had, now have, or in the future may have against the Releasees, or any of them, including claims resulting from any negligence of Newcomers or any Releasees (but not their gross negligence or intentional or reckless misconduct), for any injury, damage, death or other loss to me, in any way connected with my enrollment or participation in any of the Activities (hereinafter “Claims”). I, for myself and my heirs, successors and assigns, hereby covenant that I shall not commence or maintain any suit, civil action, arbitration proceeding or the like against the Releasees, or any of them, with regard to any Claims as defined above.

I agree that the substantive laws of the Commonwealth Massachusetts govern this document and all other aspects of my relationship with the Releasees. This document is intended to be interpreted and enforced to the fullest extent allowed by law. Any portion of this document deemed unlawful or unenforceable shall not affect the remaining provisions, and those remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

EFFECT OF AGREEMENT. This document is legally binding. By signing it you are giving up valuable rights, including the right to sue for injuries or death. Read it carefully. Do not sign unless or until you understand and agree.
